The 1st peak often takes more than 1 candle to hit its max. Reversal usually exceeds the peak. Look for 20–40 ticks on the spike, 30–50 ticks on the 2nd peak, and 20–40 ticks on the reversal.

Occasionally (3 out of last 12 reports) has a second peak for only about 10–20% more ticks than the first peak around 12–28 minutes after the report release. Reversal usually yields 15–30 ticks in 16–21 minutes after the release; however if there is a second peak, look for the reversal to take 35–55 minutes.
