A top tier report that almost always delivers a large reaction. Last month had a dull reaction after a matching forecast. Normally it does not have a 2nd peak, but the 1st peak often takes more than 1 candle to hit its max. Reversal usually exceeds the peak. Look for 35-50 ticks on the spike and 50-70 ticks on the reversal.

Trade with caution and ensure you understand the risk. Use a 10 tick buffer for this trade to avoid a premature fill in the wrong direction.

Look for 30–50 ticks on the spike, and 40–60 ticks on the reversal. If the initial spike pops for only 15–20 ticks, get out there if possible, because a reversal is likely forthcoming. Does not routinely abide by the laws of supply and demand.

Lately volatile reactions are caused by offsetting results in the crude and the products. It is also a safe play to wait out the initial reaction to check the results and enter a manual trade 2–5 min after the report breaks. Paper trade this if you have not traded this report before.

The last meeting in March was a non-mover as the FED was deferring action to this meeting. They will have to act in some capacity, even if just to tweak things. This report often breaks early or late but hardly ever on time. Keep an eye on the news or the Marketwatch.com Breaking News ticker and watch for the announcement of the result as this is the reaction to the written statement and will likely be the catalyst of a FAN long or short. If you get in on the FAN, stay in for at least about 30 min and then keep an eye on the MACD and 13/20 SMAs for indications of the termination of the FAN usually by 60 min at the latest. If you see a large candle or series of 3-5 candles that yield 40 or more ticks, that is also a good spot to get out in the 30-60 min area. If you trade the reversal, wait to get in until the MACD crosses with angle, then go for about half as many ticks as the FAN maximum (if there is a pivot point or major SMA in the vicinity that is also a good place to exit).
