The last 3 reports were strongly negative, with an uptick in the rate, a dismal increase of only ~70K jobs each month, and downward revisions of the previous reports. In June and July, the market reacted accordingly and fell precipitously. The ADP report on Wednesday showed a better than expected 163K jobs were created. While there is little correlation between the BOLS report and the ADP report, this is possibly a bullish indicator. Remember the # of jobs created carries more weight here than the U-3 % of unemployed, but if the rate change offsets the job #s, it can cause initial indecision. The investors are also suspect of the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) cooking the books. It is easier to fudge the rate than the # of jobs. Look for 40-80 ticks on the spike, a possible 2nd peak north of 100 ticks, and a reversal of 60-120 ticks.

The 1st peak often takes more than 1 candle to hit its max. Reversal usually exceeds the peak. Look for 20-40 ticks on the spike and 20-40 ticks on the reversal.
